- **A. Letha Stokes, Chief Executive Officer** Letha Stokes, Chief Executive Officer presented to the board the following:
 - 1. Letha Stokes presented to the board the hospital will celebrate National Rural Health Day in recognition of all those who go the extra mile a million times over and the "Power of Rural" on Thursday, November 17, 2022;
 - 2. Letha Stokes presented to the board the hospital Health Fair was very successful with an amazing turn out with good physician, employee, and community involvement. Letha Stokes expressed appreciation to all Board Members that attended. Letha Stokes introduced to the board the Health Fair facilitator Jo Beth Smith, Chief Operating Officer, to present to the board. Jo Beth Smith presented to the board the Health Fair statistical outcomes of attendee count, vendor booths and nine hospital booths. Eight services were provided for a total of eighty screenings performed. Jo Beth Smith presented to the board the Health Fair sponsors. Jo Beth Smith presented to the board the Health Fair theme: "Healthy-The New Happy". Jo Beth Smith presented the Health Fair had a variety of booths and good turn out of local vendors;
 - 3. Letha Stokes introduced to the board Diane Sherrill, Director of Nursing and Registered Nurse, to share with the board and community an update on hospital COVID policies. Diane Sherrill presented to the board in collaboration with Medical Staff, Infection Control Medical Director Physician, and Administrative Staff the hospital district revised the COVID plan to meet new Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines for COVID protocols in mask and monitoring. Diane Sherrill informed the board the COVID plan was revised with areas of consideration to health screenings, mask mandate, patient visitation, and entry access to the hospital;

A. Receive Board Education Session regarding Update on Texas Rural Hospital Outlook – Brent Fuller, Partner and Certified Public Accountant, with Durbin & Company, L.L.P.

David Sanderson introduced to the board Brent Fuller, Partner and Accountant with Durbin & Company. Brent Fuller presented to the board a board education session regarding update on Texas rural hospital outlook. Brent Fuller presented to the board the paradigm shift of enrollment numbers and claim reimbursement rates for both traditional Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans. Emphasis on hospitals to review and negotiate contracts with the Medicare advantage plans. Brent Fuller presented to the board the data of the May 2022 national health expenditures report, to include a future increase in healthcare costs and anticipated Medicare budgeted spending shortfall in relation to the cost of providing healthcare services. Brent Fuller presented to the board the future of healthcare transition from reactive to proactive screenings and community engagement. The board had the opportunity to ask questions. Brent Fuller, Partner and Certified Public Accountant, Durbin & Company, L.L.P. facilitated discussion with Letha Stokes, Chief Executive Officer, Colby Reeves, Chief Financial Officer, and the Board of Directors on the hospital districts financial position for traditional Medicare Medicare and advantage plans. Medicare reimbursement for telemedicine, and Medicare low volume payment adjustment and budget.-No action was taken by the board.
